



2017 Region 12 Youth Scholarship

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic ability, leadership, community service, and involvement in equine activities. Scholarship winners are to use the award toward undergraduate educational expenses at institutions of higher learning. An institution of higher learning is defined as one which may only be attended upon receipt of a high school diploma or its equivalent, which includes colleges, universities, junior or community colleges offering an associate degree, and trade schools providing education in a field leading to permanent employment.

Region XII will offer three scholarships: one for \$3000, one for \$2000, and one for \$1000 to three graduating high school seniors to further their educational studies.

Eligibility

Each applicant must be a current member of a Region XII club, must reside in Region XII, and must be a graduating high school senior when applying.

Requirements: PLEASE SUBMIT ONE ELECTRONIC FILE

1. Four Letters of recommendation as follows:
 - a. One from a horseman or horsewoman
 - b. One from an academic teacher or advisor
 - c. One from an adult member of your Region 12 Club
 - d. One from an employer or clergy or community leader
1. High school transcript, to be submitted after the fall semester of current year.
2. Head and shoulder photograph of applicant; photo to be approximately 3 x 5 inches.
3. Photograph of applicant with an equine partner – informal or show (need photo permission).
4. Complete activities summary, with emphasis on equine-related activities. (see attached sheet)
5. Copy of current AHA membership card.
6. One page letter stating applicant's reasons for wanting a scholarship and personal goals for furthering the educational experience.
