



Western Carolinas All-Star Stallion Futurity Auction Free Mare Nomination

This certificate entitles the owner or legal manager of the Stallion, _____,

All Star Stallion (ASFSA) # _____,

to one free mare nomination (value \$50) to be used the year the stallion's stud service is donated, or in the year following service donation.

Example: Stallion participates in the All-Star Stallion Auction in 2014; free nomination can be used in 2014 or 2015, with resulting baby eligible to be shown as a weanling in 2015 or 2016. The last year to nominate this stallion's get with this free nomination is 2015.

If the stallion owner uses this certificate, it can be used to nominate a mare bred to any stallion. In the event that stallion owner chooses to transfer the nomination, it is transferable to a client of his choice, so long as the mare nominated was bred to the above ASFSA stallion.

All rules and regulations concerning the All-Star Stallion Futurity Auction and the Western Carolinas Futurity program apply. Stallion owner or his/her designated client must obtain WCAHA membership status at the time the free mare nomination is exercised.

This certificate must be signed by the WCAHA Futurity Chair or club president and be submitted in its original form with the mare nomination form to be valid.
